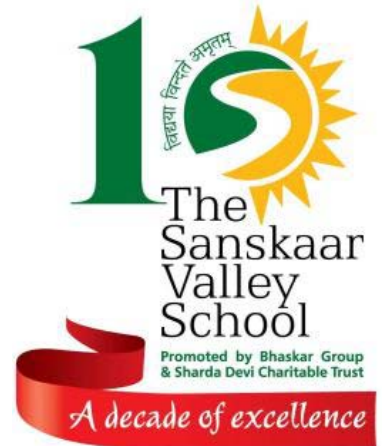

Shikhar: Exploring Sericulture at 'Prakrit' Hosangabad

On November 20, 2016 Grade 10 boarding children took a Geography field trip to explore Sericulture and visited 'Prakrit' in Hoshangabad.

Our first stop was to learn about silk worm rearing, where the silkworms are cultured. We also came to know that different types of feeds and different types of worms results in different varieties of silk like Mulberry, Muga, Eri and Tussar.



Consequently we went to the site where all the raw material was processed and converted to fine silk yarn. After this we went to Prakrit's retail outlet where we saw various types of clothings made out of silk such as Sarees, jackets, ties, scarves etc. Then we had an interactive session with the director of Prakrit where we came to know the nitty gritty of agro based industries and how it is reaching out to the cause of rural development and generating employment.
