Fee Rules :-

1. The fee has to be paid under two heads.

Part-I.: At the time of Admission (One time fee)

Part-II.: Annual Fee

- 2. Part II (a) can be paid in two installments. First installment (50%) is to be paid along with Part I at the time of admission & Second installment (50%) by mid August.
- 3. Part II (b), (c) and (d) have to be paid along with the first installment at the time of admission.
 - Pocket money would cover expenses relating to visits to the Tuck Shop and any private/ escorted day outings (and related personal expenditure e.g., stationery and toiletries) that the child may undertake from school.
 - The imprest amount will take into consideration the expenses related to uniform, books and notebooks, and other consumables that the child may require during the term. The top up for Imprest Amount will have to be done in October/ November (during Diwali Break) against the raised Imprest bill.
- 4. The fee does not include any other expenses of personal nature. It also does not include international school trips & excursions or more than a trip within India that might be held during the term.
- 5. Fee does not include school trips and outside activities held during the school term. They will be charged on actuals before the event.
- 6. All NRI or students of foreign origin will be required to pay in U.S. dollars or its equivalent in Indian currency.
