55+ Universities from India, USA, UK, Scotland, Ireland, Australia, Canada, & Switzerland participated at the Global Career Fair @ TSVS, organized by Samcara (Career Counseling Cell). Students from grades 9-12 interacted directly with the University representatives to get first-hand information about various programs, eligibility criteria, scholarship options, fee structure, and much more to choose the right fit university. Education USA and SIUK were also part of the event to help the students get deeper knowledge about studying in USA and UK respectively.

Prof. Moitrayee Das (Flame University), delved into the unique mental health challenges faced by Gen Z and Gen Alpha. MOOT COURT



Inter School Junior Moot Court Event was organized by The Sanskaar Valley School in collaboration with **IFIM & Vijaybhoomi University**. A 3-week long competition, opened with an online orientation session for the participants to a written memorial submission and then finally an in-person event on 25th September. This was the first time any school in Bhopal organized such an event for Law aspirants. 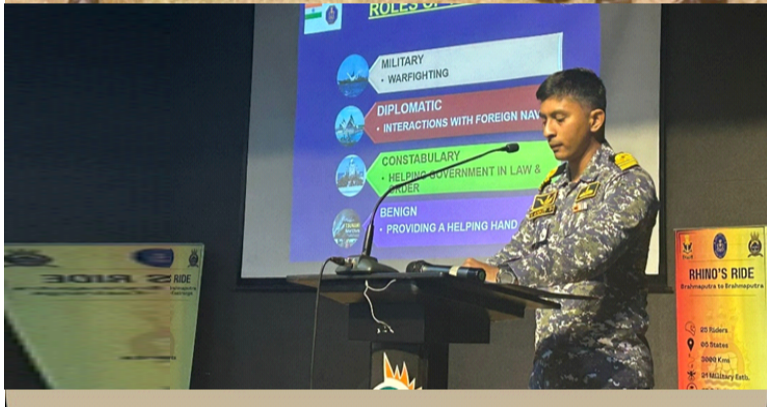

ACCESS USA

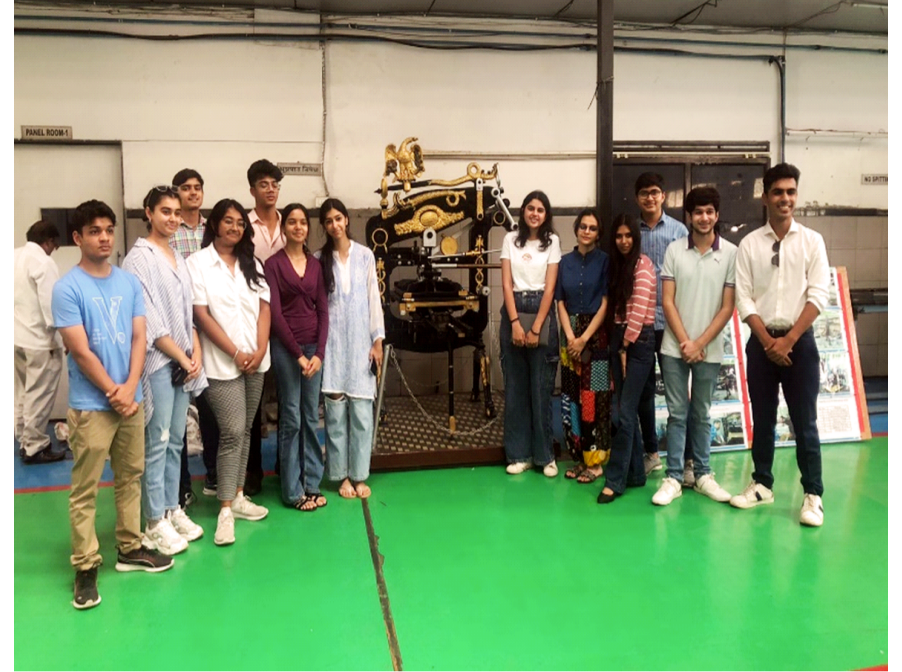
